Photographs

School Uniform

As the school year end approaches, we have noticed a slip in uniform standards. We are not expecting you to buy new uniform now but just a reminder for September:

Socks: plain white, plain grey or plain black

School Shoes: Black – no slip-on ballet type shoes as they are dangerous on the playground as they slip off easily

PE Trainers: Some fashion trainers are creeping in with hi tops, coloured and converse and Vans type trainers being worn. These are not suitable for PE.

Supermarket sports trainers are ideal and low cost.

Water Bottles

Please make sure your child has a water bottle in school. We have seen an increase in single use plastic bottles being brought in lately.

Another plea for September – Plastic, reusable water bottles with names on. Again, water bottles are becoming a fashion accessory, with young children bringing in Stanley type cups adorned with all sorts of accessories! Metal 'Chilly' type bottles should also be avoided as they are very heavy when full and if they fall off counters or are swung around, they can hurt.
