THIS WEEKEND ~ Our Holy Father is Canonizing two young men: Pier Giorgio Frassati & Carlo Acutis. Pier was born in Turin in 1901. From a young age he devoted his time caring for the poor and sick. He became an activist promoting the Catholic Church's social teaching based on the principles of Pope Leo XIII's encyclical letter, Rerum Novarum. He contracted Polio whilst caring for the sick and died in 1925, aged 24.

Carlo was born in London in 1991 but was raised in Milan. From an early age, Carlo had great devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, preaching to his peers and creating a website promoting Eucharistic miracles and Eucharistic devotion. He was diagnosed with leukemia and died in 2006 at the young age of fifteen.
